

FABRIC A - Garden Patch Panel

flower squares centered

with background check

Cuttina:

11 ½"x 6" large border


Fussy cut six - 11 ½"x 6" Large flower borders with flowers centered on strip.



Fussy cut six - 11 1/2" x 3" Mini flower borders with black background with flowers centered on strip.


FABRIC B: Breezy Blooms - 1 1/8 yards


FABRIC C: Breezy Blooms Toss - 3/8 yard




FABRIC D: Scribble Dot - 1/3 yard or FQ each


■ WOF - Width of Fabric, selvage to selvage —



Dark green & Orange each:

Cut one strip - 191/2" x 3" Cut one strip - 6"x 3"

Cut four squares - 6"x 6"



FABRIC E: Scribble, black - 23/4 yards Sashing, Backing & Binding *Diagram E*

Sashing: Trim selvage. Cut two strips, 25" x WOF.

Crosscut for seventeen strips 4 ½" x 25" according to diagram.

Backing: Cut two strips 11 1/2" x WOF. Set aside.



Each 25" x WOF strip yields nine strips


Binding: Cut eight strips, 2 1/2" x WOF for binding.

FABRIC F: Whirl - 3/8 yard Cornerstones

Pink / Yellow - Cornerstone squares in sashing Cut two strips, 4 ½" x WOF. Crosscut for twelve - 4 ½" x 4 ½" squares


FABRIC G & E: Check Dot Plaid - 3 3/4 yards Backing | Diagram G



After assembling quilt front, pin RSU to batting & backing.

Ouilt as desired.

Follow steps 4-7 below.



F0 = Fat Ouarter - 22" X 18" WOF = Width of Fabric RST = Right Sides Together WST = Wrong Sides Together RSU = Right Side UpWSU = Wrong Side Up

Assembly:

- 1. Using 1/4" seam allowance throughout, assemble each of the blocks in groups according to Construction Diagram & cover photo.
- 2. Press fabrics as indicated by arrows in diagram.
- 3. Pin to batting & backing. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Sew binding strips into one long strip. Press in half lengthwise wrong sides together.
- 5. Bind using preferred technique.
