
60" x 72" Quilt








- ◆ Ouilt as desired
- ◆ Sew binding strips into one long strip.
- ◆ Press in half lengthwise wrong sides together.
- ◆ Align raw edge of binding to raw edge of quilt.
- ◆ Sew binding to front of quilt using miter edge technique at corners.
- ◆ Hand sew binding to the back of the quilt.



Assembly:

- Using ¼" seam allowance throughout, assemble each of the blocks in groups according to the diagram on left. Note stripe direction for proper placement.
- Press fabrics towards the darkest fabrics.
- ◆ Join each group together following the diagram below.
- Sew four sets of inner border strips together.
- Measure quilt from top to bottom at middle.
- Cut inner side borders to this measurement.
- ◆ Attach to sides, press towards border.
- ◆ Measure quilt from left side to right side at middle.
- ◆ Cut top and bottom borders to this measurement.
- ◆ Press towards inner border.
- Sew four sets of outer border strips together.
- Measure and attach borders in the same manner as inner borders.
